WHEREAS the Trinidad and Tobago Association for ^{Preamble}
Retarded Children (hereinafter referred to as “the
Organisation”) was incorporated as a body corporate by
the Trinidad and Tobago Association for Retarded
Children Ordinance, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as ^{Ordinance No. 15 of}
“the Ordinance”); ¹⁹⁶¹

And whereas the Organisation has advised that it is now desirous of amending the Ordinance to change its name to the Lady Hochoy Centres of Trinidad and Tobago to further its objectives:

Enactment ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:

Short title **1.** This Act may be cited as the Trinidad and Tobago Association for Retarded Children (Incorporation) (Amendment) Act, 2022.

Ordinance No. 15 of 1961 amended **2.** The Trinidad and Tobago Association for Retarded Children Ordinance, 1961 is amended—

(a) in the preamble and in section 2, by deleting the words “the Territory” and substituting the words “Trinidad and Tobago”;

(b) by deleting the words “Trinidad and Tobago Association for Retarded Children” wherever they occur in—

(i) the long title;

(ii) the preamble; and

(iii) sections 1 and 2,

and substituting in each place the words “Lady Hochoy Centres of Trinidad and Tobago”; and

(c) by deleting the words “association” and “Association” wherever they occur and substituting the words “organisation” and “Organisation”, respectively.
