# GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE MINISTER OF FINANCE In compliance with Section 7(4) of The Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Chap. 22:02

Where a statement has not been published by a public authority in accordance with section 7(1) of the Freedom of Information Act, Chap. 22:02 (the Act) the responsible Minister shall promptly give reasons to be published in the Gazette, for the failure to publish.

And whereas the **Caribbean Airlines Limited** (the Company), a public authority assigned to the Ministry of Finance, has not published in the Gazette and a daily newspaper in circulation, the required annual statements for the period 2016-2021, the Minister accordingly now provides the following reasons:

- 1. For the years 2016 to 2017, the Company was engaged in a commercially sensitive and intensive undertaking to formulate a new strategic plan to position the Company into a period of competitiveness, profitability and sustainability. The Company had to prioritize its key resources towards this time sensitive exercise.
- 2. Thereafter and up to early 2020 the Company began an aggressive roll out of its strategic initiatives aimed at optimizing operational efficiency and business turnaround. Some of these initiatives included:
- I. Overhaul of the ICT Network and infrastructure to improve its passenger service system, business intelligence generation, software developments, amongst other extensive projects.
- II. Commercial and Cargo related operational Initiatives.
- III. Business rebranding.
- IV. Creation of additional products and services aimed at improving its customer experience.

This strategic and operational exercise spanned across four (4) years and the Company was incapacitated in its ability to draft and publish the required statements.

3. Further, the operations of the Company were temporarily suspended because of the declaration by the World Health Organisation (WHO) on March 11, 2020, of a global pandemic with the spread of the COVID-19 virus, and the subsequent closure of the borders of Trinidad & Tobago by the Government of Trinidad and Tobago on March 23, 2020, to air transportation of passengers into and out of Trinidad & Tobago. The prolonged border closure and curtailed operations also led to a company-wide manpower reduction exercise which engaged key resources. Additionally, in an effort to mitigate the spread of the virus, the Company implemented increased safety measures which included a reduction in social interaction in the workplace by allowing non-essential staff to work from home which resulted in a staggered workflow. When the borders were re-opened on July 17th, 2021, CAL resumed its operations on a reduced level with continued staggered workflow. As efforts are being made to incrementally return to a safe level of in-person work flows every effort will be made to publish the required Section 7(1) Annual Statement by June 30, 2022, in keeping with the statutory requirements under the FOIA. Every effort is being made by the Company to publish its annual statement in 2022, at the earliest convenience, in keeping with its statutory obligations arising from the Act.
