INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—December, 2021 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of December, 2021, was 113.3, representing a decrease of 0.3 point or 0.3% below the All Items Index for November, 2021.

The Rate of Inflation, as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January to December, 2021, over the period January to December, 2020, was 2.0%. This rate is greater than that observed for the period January to December, 2019, which was 0.6%.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 128.2 in November, 2021 to 127.0 in December, 2021, reflecting a decrease of 0.9%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was the general downward movement in the prices of pumkin, whole chickens—fresh, powdered milk—full cream, chive, celery, green (sweet) pepper, melongene, mixed fresh seasoning, hot pepper and salted pig tail. The full impact of these price decreases was offset by the general increases in the prices of whole chickens—frozen, tomatoes, other chilled or frozen chicken (parts), white flour, table margarine, pimento, low fat milk, oranges, sweet potatoes and fresh, chilled , frozen or seasoned beef.

Price changes in this section for the month of December, 2021 accounted for a net overall decrease of 0.2 point in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for December, 2021 compared with November, 2021, reflected decreases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.3%, Clothing and Footwear of 0.1% and Health of 0.6%. All other sections remained unchanged.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of December, 2021 accounted for a net overall decrease of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.
