Made by the Minister of Works and Transport under section 65 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (NAPARIMA-MAYARO ROAD, PRINCES TOWN) ORDER, 2022

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Naparima-Mayaro Citation Road, Princes Town) Order, 2022.
 - 2. This Order comes into operation on Monday 16th May, 2022. Commencement
- 3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the western Parking and eastern sides of the Naparima-Mayaro Road, Princes Town from M1 Tasker Road to Lothians Road.
- 4. A person who contravenes this Order commits a traffic violation Traffic violation and is liable to a fine of three thousand dollars.
- 5. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by a commission $_{\text{Removal and}}$ of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention of this $_{\text{unilawfully}}^{\text{impounding of}}$ Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in $_{\text{parked}}^{\text{unilawfully}}$ accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road $_{\text{Chap. 48:50}}^{\text{Chap. 48:50}}$ Traffic Act.
