ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(INDEPENDENCE DAY STREET FAIR, TOBAGO) ORDER, 2022

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Independence Day Street Fair, Tobago) Order, 2022.

2. This Order has effect from 7.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. on Duration Wednesday 31st August, 2022.

3. (1) A person driving a motor vehicle entering Scarborough— Traffic routes

(a) from west to east, along the Crusoe By-Pass, shall turn north onto Orange Hill Road and onto the Claude Noel Highway; and

(b) from west to east could do so along the Claude Noel Highway.

(2) A person driving a motor vehicle exiting Scarborough may proceed along Wilson Road or the Northside Connector Road or Bacolet Connector Road.

4. No person shall drive a motor vehicle— Vehicular traffic prohibited

(a) along Milford Road between Sangster's Hill and the roundabout in the vicinity of Crusoe By-Pass and Orange Hill Road; and

(b) onto Milford Road from the following streets:

(i) Breezehall Mall;

(ii) Mt. Marie, in the vicinity of Barcode; and

(iii) Smithfield No. 1.

5. A person shall not park on— Parking prohibited

(a) Milford Road; and

(b) Orange Hill Road.

6. A driver of an emergency vehicle shall proceed north along Breeze Hall Road and continue north unto Mount Marie Road and east or west unto Claude Noel Highway.

Removal and

7. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
