ORDER

Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (TOBAGO CARNIVAL) ORDER, 2022

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restrictions (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Tobago Carnival) Order, 2022.

PART I

Crown Point

- 2. This Part takes effect on Saturday 29th October, 2022 between Duration the hours of 3.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m.
 - 3. Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on—

Vehicular traffic and parking prohibited

- (a) Milford Road, Canaan, between Stumpy's Bypass Road and parking Milford Road, Crown Point;
- (b) Milford Road, between Douglas Street and Centre Street;
- (c) Store Bay Local Road, between Milford Road, Crown Point and Kilgwyn Bay Road; and
- (d) Milford Road Bypass, Crown Point, between Store Bay Local Road and Pigeon Point junction.
- 4. Parking is prohibited on—

Parking prohibited

- (a) Douglas Street;
- (b) Roberts Street;
- (c) George Street; and
- (d) Centre Street.
- 5. Notwithstanding clause 3, public parking may be permitted at Public the Store Bay Heritage Park and the Store Bay Beach Facility Car Park parking in accordance with the directions of a Police Officer who is on duty.
- 6. In cases of emergency at Crown Point, vehicular traffic shall Emergency proceed along Store Bay Local Road, Crown Point, turn east along route Milford Road, Canaan, north onto Centre Street, and east onto Guy Street to the Canaan Health Centre.

Ingress and Egress routes 7. Notwithstanding clause 3, a person driving a vehicle shall proceed along Store Bay Local Road, Friendship Extension Road, Golden Grove Road, St. Cyr Street, Douglas Road and Guy Street to access a residence.

Band route

8. The parade route for Carnival in Crown Point shall commence from the junction of Stumpy's Bypass Road and Milford Road, Canaan, then proceed west along Milford Road, Canaan/Bon Accord, and south along Milford Road Bypass to the Store Bay Local Road.

PART II

Roxborough

Duration

9. This Part takes effect on Saturday 29th October, 2022 between the hours of 4.00 p.m. and midnight.

Vehicular traffic prohibited 10. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on the Windward Main Road, between Boston Street and Prince Street.

Parking prohibited

- 11. Parking is prohibited on—
 - (a) Lammy Road;
 - (b) Cameron Canal Road;
 - (c) Station Hill Bypass;
 - (d) Police Station Street; and
 - (e) Boston Street.

Vehicular traffic permitted

- 12. Vehicular traffic is permitted on—
 - (a) Lammy Road;
 - (b) Cameron Canal Road;
 - (c) Station Hill Bypass;
 - (d) Police Station Street; and
 - (e) Boston Street.

Band route

13. The parade route for Carnival in Roxborough shall commence from the junction of Lammy Road on the Windward Main Road, proceed east along the Windward Main Road to Boston Street junction, and then return along the Windward Main Road, proceeding west to the junction of Blood Bay Road, Roxborough.

PART III

SCARBOROUGH

- 14. This Part takes effect on Sunday 30th October, 2022 between Duration the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m.
 - 15. Vehicular traffic is prohibited—

Vehicular traffic

- (a) on Carrington Street, between Bay Street and Milford prohibited Road, Scarborough;
- (b) on Milford Road, Scarborough between Carrington Street and Cemetery Street, including Orange Hill Road and Crusoe Bypass Road; and
- (c) along the Claude Noel Highway, from the Wilson Road and Plymouth Road intersection to the Lambeau/Signal Hill Road and Claude Noel Highway intersection.
- 16. Parking is prohibited on—

Parking prohibited

- (a) Wilson Road, between Carrington Street and the Claude Noel Highway;
- (b) Milford Road, Scarborough, between Wilson Road and Orange Hill Road;
- (c) Garden Side Street;
- (d) North Side Connector Road;
- (e) Bay Street;
- (f) Orange Hill Road, between the junction of Crusoe Bypass and Milford Road, Scarborough, including the roundabout at Crusoe Bypass;
- (g) Claude Noel Highway, between Wilson Road and Cemetery Street, Lambeau;
- (h) Village Street, Lambeau, between Village Street junction and Milford Road, Lambeau; and
- (i) Milford Road, Lambeau.
- 17. Parking is prohibited in—
 - (a) the Market Square Car Park; and

Parking prohibited in specified areas

(b) the Old First Citizens Bank Car Park on Carrington Street.

Taxi stands

- 18. The temporary relocation of taxi stands are as follows:
 - (a) West End Taxis plying the Canaan/Bon Accord/Crown Point/Signal Hill/Patience Hill and Bethel routes shall park on Plymouth Road from the junction of Pump Mill Road, facing North; and
 - (b) taxis plying the Windward and Northern district routes shall park on the northern shoulder of the Claude Noel Highway, east of the Claude Noel Highway and Plymouth Road intersection, facing East.

Band route

19. The parade route for Carnival in Scarborough shall commence between Smithfield Road No. 1 and Smithfield Trace No. 2, proceed east along Milford Road, north onto Wilson Road, west onto the Claude Noel Highway, south onto Cemetery Street, east onto Milford Road, Lambeau, continue east along Crusoe Bypass, then south onto Orange Hill Road and east onto Milford Road, Scarborough, to return to the starting point at Smithfield Road No. 1.

PART IV GENERAL

Emergency routes to Scarborough General Hospital

- 20. In case of an emergency, all emergency vehicles shall proceed—
 - (a) along the eastbound lane of the Claude Noel Highway;
 - (b) from the west, along the Claude Noel Highway, turn north at the Lambeau/Signal Hill Road and Claude Noel Highway intersection, onto the Signal Hill/Lambeau Connector Road, then east onto the Signal Hill Main Road and southeast onto the Old Government Farm Road to the Scarborough General Hospital; and
 - (c) from the east, along the Claude Noel Highway, turn north at the Plymouth Road and Wilson Road intersection, then west onto Spring Garden Trace, south along Spring Garden Road, west onto Spring Garden Extension, north onto Orange Hill Road, cross the bridge onto Signal Hill Main Road, and then turn southeast onto the Old Government Farm Road to the Scarborough General Hospital.

Access to prohibited routes 21. Notwithstanding clauses 3, 10 and 15, a person driving a vehicle may traverse prohibited routes at the discretion of and in accordance with the directions of a Police Officer who is on duty.

22. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention impounding of vehicles of this Order may be removed by a member of the Police Service and unlawfully impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1) of the parked Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chap 48:50.
