ORDER

Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (NATIONAL DAY OF REMEMBRANCE) ORDER, 2022

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary _{Citation} Provisions) (National Day of Remembrance) Order, 2022.

2. This Order shall have effect from 6.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on Duration Sunday 13th November, 2022.

3. Subject to subclause (2), a driver of a motor vehicle shall not park Parking prohibited

- (a) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Dundonald Street;
- (b) Queen's Park East;
- (c) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane;
- (d) Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Dundonald Street;
- (e) Frederick Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West;
- (f) Abercromby Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
- (g) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
- (h) New Street, between Pembroke Street and Charlotte Street;
- (i) Chancery Lane; and
- (j) Jerningham Avenue, between Queen's Park East and Norfolk Street.

(2) Notwithstanding subclause (1), police officers on duty may allow a military vehicle, specially invited guests or any other person to park.

(3) For the purposes of this clause, "military vehicle" means a motor vehicle controlled by the military forces whilst such vehicle is being used for military purposes in accordance with section 42(7) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. A driver shall not drive his motor vehicle from 8.00 a.m. to traffic 1.00 p.m. onprohibited (a) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Keate Street; (b) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Frederick Street; (c) Queen's Park East, between Jerningham Avenue and Queen's Park West; (d) Charlotte Street, between Queen's Park West; and Gordon Street: (e) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street; and (f) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street. 5. From 8.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon, a driver of a motor vehicle Vehicular traffic routes proceeding-(a) south on Queen's Park East shall turn east onto Jerningham Avenue; (b) west of Jerningham Avenue, between Belmont Circular Road and Norfolk Street, shall turn north or south onto Norfolk Street: (c) south on Archer Street shall turn east unto Jerningham Avenue; (d) north on Charlotte Street shall turn west onto Gordon Street; and (e) north on Henry Street shall turn east onto New Street or west unto Gordon Street. 6. From 8.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon, a driver of a motor vehicle shall One-way

6. From 8.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon, a driver of a motor vehicle shall proceed in an easterly direction only on Jerningham Avenue, between Queen's Park East and Norfolk Street.

Two minutes of silence 7. During the observance of the two minutes of silence from 11.00 a.m. to 11.02 a.m., police officers on duty shall bring to a standstill all vehicular traffic within the area bounded on the north by Queen's Park West, on the south by Gordon Street, on the east partly by

Queen's Park East and partly by Charlotte Street and on the west by Chancery Lane.

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention $_{of vehicles}^{impounding}$ of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt unlawfully with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
