REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)
(SIPARIA) REGULATIONS, 2022

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation
(Experimental Scheme) (Siparia) Regulations, 2022.

2. In These Regulations shall the term “S.S. Erin Road” means the Interpretation
San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road.

3. These Regulations, shall commence on Monday 28th November, 2022 Duration
and expire on Monday 27th February, 2023.

4. (1) Parking is prohibited on—

Parking
Prohibited

(a) Lalla Street, Siparia; and

(b) De Gannes Lane, Siparia,

between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except
on public holidays.

(2) A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park—

(a) on the western side of the S.S. Erin Road, between the 19.97
mile mark and the 20.00 mile mark; and

(b) along the entry and exit ramps in front of the Siparia
Market compound.

5. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn rightNo right turn
from—

(a) Lalla Street, onto the S.S. Erin Road; and

(b) Daisy Voisin Street onto the S.S. Erin Road,

between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00p.m.,
Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

Traffic violation
and penalty

6. A person who contravenes these Regulations commits a traffic violation and is liable to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars for the first traffic violation and to a fine of one thousand dollars for every subsequent traffic violation.

Removal and
impounding of
vehicles
unlawfully
parked

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by a member of the Police Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chap. 48:50..
