ORDER

Made by the Minister under regulation 10(14) of the Immigration Regulations, 1974

THE IMMIGRATION (EXEMPTION FROM WORK PERMIT) (VENEZUELAN NATIONALS) ORDER, 2022

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Exemption From Citation Work Permit) (Venezuelan Nationals) Order, 2022.
 - 2. In this Order— Interpretation
 - "designated period" means the period from 31st May, 2019 to 14th June, 2019, inclusive;
 - "permit" means the written permit referred to in section 10 of the Act;
 - "registrant card" means the card issued pursuant to clause 4;
 - "the Regulations" means the Immigration Regulations, 1974;
 - G.N. No. 178 of 1974
 - "Venezuelan national" means a national of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela; and
 - "Venezuelan registrant" means a Venezuelan national who applied for a permit during the designated period and was issued a permit.
- 3. A Venezuelan registrant who is issued a permit is exempt from Work permit the requirement for a work permit to engage in employment in Trinidad exemption and Tobago as prescribed by regulation 10 of the Regulations.
- 4. (1) The Minister shall cause to be issued to a Venezuelan Registrant registrant, who is the holder of a permit, a registrant card displaying, ^{card} inter alia, the following particulars of the registrant—
 - (a) his name;
 - (b) his date of birth;
 - (c) a photograph of himself; and
 - (d) the expiration date of his permit.
- (2) Where a registrant card is lost, stolen or mutilated, the Venezuelan registrant may request the issuance of a duplicate registrant card.

	(3) The request for a duplicate registrant card shall be accompanied by—
	(a) a fee of five hundred dollars; and
Schedule	(b) a signed declaration in the form set out in the Schedule.
	(4) Where a registrant card is mutilated, a duplicate registrant card shall not be issued until the mutilated registrant card has been delivered for destruction.
