A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 2 of the Trinidad and Tobago Revenue Authority Act, 2021 (Act No. 17 of 2021) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) that the Act comes into force on such date as is fixed by the President by Proclamation:

And whereas it is provided by section 5(2)(c) of the Statutes Act, Chap. 3:02, that where a statute provides that it is to come into force by the President by Proclamation, or that it is not to come into force until a day or date to be so fixed, any such Proclamation may suspend until further proclamation or until a specified date, the operation of any provision contained in the statute:

And whereas it is expedient that sections 1, 2, 3, 5(1), 6(1)(g), 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14(1)(c), 15, 16, 17, 23(1) and (2), 23(3)(a), (b), (c), (e), (f), (g) and (h), 24, 25, 27(1), 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 35, 36, 38, 41 and 42 and the Schedule of the Act come into force and that the operation of section 18 of the Act be suspended until further proclamation:

Now, therefore, I, PAULA-MAE WEEKES, President as aforesaid, do hereby fix the 15th day of March, 2022, as the date on which sections 1, 2, 3, 5(1), 6(1)(g), 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14(1)(c), 15, 16, 17, 23(1) and (2), 23(3)(a), (b), (c), (e), (f), (g) and (h), 24, 25, 27(1), 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 35, 36, 38, 41 and 42 and the Schedule of the Act come into force and suspend the operation of section 18 of the Act until further proclamation.
