MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(POINT FORTIN BOROUGH DAY LAUNCH) ORDER, 2022

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Point Fortin Borough Day Launch) Order, 2022.

2. This Order shall have effect between the hours of 6.00 p.m. to Duration 12.00 midnight on Friday 22nd April, 2022.

3. A driver shall not park his motor vehicle on—

Parking prohibited

- (a) Bryce Road;
- (b) Main Field Road;
- (c) Morris Road;
- (d) Church Road;
- (e) Nurse Street;
- (f) Alleyne Street; and
- (g) School Road.

4. A driver shall not drive his motor vehicle on—

Vehicular traffic prohibited

- (a) Point Fortin Main Road, between Frisco Roundabout and Main Field Road;
- (b) Main Field Road; and
- (c) School Road, between Nurse Street and Main Field Road.

5. (1) A driver entering Point Fortin from the Southern Main Road shall— Traffic route

- (a) proceed east around Frisco Roundabout onto 2nd Street, then onto Caanan Road onto Richardson Street; or
- (b) proceed west onto Bryce Road onto Cap-de-ville Main Road.

(2) A driver leaving Point Fortin accessing the Southern Main Road shall—

- (a) proceed south along Caanan Road onto 2nd Street, then west onto Richardson Street; or
- (b) from Cap-de-ville Main Road, proceed east onto Bryce Road, then south onto the Southern Main Road.

Relocation of  
taxi stands

6. The following taxi stands are relocated as follows:

- (a) the San Fernando taxi stand, to the lay-by on the eastern side of Point Fortin Main Road, approximately 500 metres north of Frisco Roundabout; and
- (b) the Cedros and Erin taxi stands, to the car park of the Point Fortin Catholic Church on the eastern side of the Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road in the vicinity of the Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road and Reid Road intersection.

Removal and  
impounding  
of vehicles  
unlawfully  
parked

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
