MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(SINGLE PAN BANDS SEMI-FINALS) ORDER, 2009

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Single Pan Bands Semi-Finals) Order, 2009.

2. This Order shall have effect between the hours of 4.00 p.m. on Monday 9th February, 2009 and 2.00 a.m. on Tuesday 10th February, 2009.

3. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on:

Road closed
parking

- (a) Ariapita Avenue, between French Street and Flament Street;
- (b) Park Street, between Flament Street and Richmond Street;
- (c) Phillip Street, between Tragarete Road and Ariapita Avenue;
- (d) Victoria Square West, between Duke Street and Ariapita Avenue;
- (e) Melbourne Street, between Duke Street and Ariapita Avenue;
- (f) Stone Street, between Duke Street and Ariapita Avenue;
- (g) Colville Street, between Wrightson Road and Ariapita Avenue; and
- (h) Colville Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Buller Street.

4. Parking is prohibited on:

prohibited

- (a) Buller Street; and
- (b) Richmond Street, between Park Street and Independence Square.

5. Bands shall assemble on Ariapita Avenue, between French Street and Colville Street, then proceed east along Ariapita Avenue onto Park Street to be judged at Victoria Square. After judging, bands will disassemble at Park Street and Richmond Street.

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
