UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)  
(NO. 3) ORDER, 2010

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for <sup>Citation</sup> Admission) (No. 3) Order, 2010.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a <sup>Eligibility for</sup> Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales <sup>admission to</sup> for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in <sup>practise</sup> Trinidad and Tobago, subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

Mr. John Lewis Powell, Q.C.	Of the Honourable Society of Middle Temple: Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in July, 1974, and was appointed Queen's Counsel in 1990.

PART II

Mr. John Lewis Powell, Q.C., is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause and any matters, suits or other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the cause, namely:
