MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF  
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(ARANGUEZ OVERPASS) ORDER, 2010

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Aranguez Overpass) Order, 2010. Citation

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 7.00 p.m. on Saturday 19th June, 2010 and 7.00 a.m. on Sunday 20th June, 2010. Duration

3. The following roads are closed to vehicular traffic between the hours of 8.00 p.m. on Saturday 19th June, 2010 and 7.00 a.m. on Sunday 20th June, 2010: Roads closed

- (a) Churchill-Roosevelt Highway east and west bound carriageways, between Aranguez Road and the Uriah Butler Highway intersection;
- (b) Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and Uriah Butler Highway interchange;
- (c) the Lay-by connecting the Uriah Butler Highway north bound carriageway to the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway; and
- (d) the Lay-by connecting the Bamboo Overpass and the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway.

4. Between the hours of 8.00 p.m. on Saturday 19th June, 2010 and 7.00 a.m. on Sunday 20th June, 2010, the traffic restriction for unauthorized vehicles using the Priority Bus Route will be relaxed. Use of Priority Bus Route

5. Two-way traffic is permitted on Aranguez Road, between the Eastern Main Road and 5th Street, between the hours of 8.00 p.m. on Saturday 19th June, 2010 and 7.00 a.m. on Sunday 20th June, 2010. Two-way traffic

6. Drivers proceeding—

- (a) west along the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and those proceeding north along the Uriah Butler Highway on reaching the Grand Bazaar intersection and wishing to continue towards Port-of-Spain shall proceed north along the Uriah Butler Highway and then west onto the Priority Bus Route and exit accordingly; Vehicular traffic routes

(b) east along the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway shall turn north onto Aranguez Road then onto the Priority Bus Route or Eastern Main Road; and

(c) south along Aranguez Road shall turn west onto the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway.

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
