A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 30(1) of the Representation of the People Act, Chap. 2:01, that for the purposes of an election the President may, by Proclamation, direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in the Registration Area Offices or Temporary Registration Area Offices established in the electoral district in which such election is to be held:

And whereas it is further provided by section 30(3) of the Act that the President may, by subsequent Proclamation, fix the date of the termination of an electoral registration:

And whereas by Proclamation dated the 8th day of April, 2010, it was directed that an electoral registration be conducted in each of the electoral districts as defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission Order, 2010, in relation to a general election of members of the House of Representatives and the 12th day of April, 2010,

was fixed as the date of the commencement of the said electoral registration:

Now, therefore, I, GEORGE MAXWELL RICHARDS, President as aforesaid, do hereby fix the 18th day of June, 2010, as the date of the termination of the electoral registration in each of the electoral districts as defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission Order, 2010.
