MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)
(CHAGUANAS/ENDEAVOUR) REGULATIONS, 2010

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation
(Experimental Scheme) (Chaguanas/Endeavour) Regulations, 2010.
2. These Regulations shall have effect from Monday Duration
13th September, 2010 to Sunday 12th December, 2010.

PART I

CHAGUANAS

3. Vehicular traffic shall proceed in either direction on Ramsaran Two-way
Street, between Southern Main Road and Marc Street. traffic
4. Parking is prohibited on— Parking
prohibited
 - (a) Southern Main Road, from Factory Road to the Triangle,
Chase Village; and
 - (b) Factory Road, from Southern Main Road to Perseverance
Road.
5. Vehicular traffic shall proceed in a— One-way
traffic
 - (a) southerly direction on Andrew Street, between Southern
Main Road and Algernon Street; and
 - (b) westerly direction on 10th Avenue, Orchard Gardens,
between Xavier Street Extension and Wilking Boulevard,
between 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.,
from Monday to Friday, except public holidays.
6. Motorists proceeding east along Southern Main Road shall not No right
turn right onto Andrew Street. turn

PART II

ENDEAVOUR

- No right turn 7. Motorists proceeding—
- (a) west on the Endeavour Flyover shall not turn right onto the northbound ramp; and
 - (b) east on the Endeavour Flyover shall not turn right onto the southbound ramp.

PART III

GENERAL

- Offence and penalty 8. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Regulations is liable on summary conviction for a first offence, to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars, and on any subsequent conviction, to a fine of one thousand dollars.

- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 9. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
