 INTENTION TO MAKE AN ORDER DECLARING COMPULSORY  
 STANDARDS

NOTICE is hereby given in accordance with section 18(2) of the Standards Act, Chap. 82:03, that the Minister of Trade and Industry, on the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, intends to make an Order declaring the following standards, which are listed in the First Column with corresponding titles in the Second Column, compulsory standards with effect from 29th December, 2010 for the purposes specified in the Third Column.

Notice is also given that these standards were notified in Legal Notice No. 210 of 2010.
