ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 18(2) OF THE STANDARDS ACT

COMPULSORY STANDARDS (NO. 2) ORDER, 2010

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Standards (No. 2) Citation Order, 2010.

2. On the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, the following standards listed in the First Column of the Schedule with the corresponding titles in the Second Column of the Schedule, which were notified in Legal Notice No. 210 of 2010, are hereby declared compulsory standards for the purposes set out in the Third Column of the Schedule.

3. This Order comes into effect on the 29th day of December, 2010.
