MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(SINGLE PAN BANDS PRELIMINARY) ORDER, 2010

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Single Pan Bands Preliminary) Order, 2010.

2. This Order shall have effect between the hours of 3.00 p.m. on Duration Sunday 17th January, 2010 and 1.00 a.m. on Monday 18th January, 2010.

3. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on—

Roads closed
and parking
prohibited

- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Duke Street and Independence Square North;
- (b) Independence Square North, between Edward Street and Henry Street;
- (c) Frederick Street, between Duke Street and Independence Square North;
- (d) Queen Street, between Henry Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (e) Knox Street, between St. Vincent Street and Frederick Street;
- (f) Hart Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (g) Abercromby Street, between Independence Square South and Duke Street;
- (h) Pembroke Street, between Knox Street and Duke Street;
- (i) Prince Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;
and
- (j) Chacon Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square South.

4. Parking is prohibited on—

Parking
prohibited

- (a) Independence Square South, between Broadway and St. Vincent Street; and
- (b) Cipriani Circle.

- Parking permitted 5. Notwithstanding clause 3(a), vehicles conveying steelpans may park on St. Vincent Street and Independence Square North.
- Taxi stands 6. Taxis shall operate as follows:
- (a) St. Ann's taxi drivers shall ply for hire on St. Vincent Street, between South Quay and Independence Square South on the eastern side;
 - (b) St. James taxi drivers shall ply for hire on St. Vincent Street, between South Quay and Independence Square South on the western side; and
 - (c) Ice House/Marine Square taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the northern and southern sides of Independence Square South, between St. Vincent Street and Edward Street.
- Band route 7. Bands shall assemble on St. Vincent Street and Independence Square North, then proceed east along Independence Square North, north along Frederick Street and west onto Knox Street in front of City Hall to be judged and on completion of their performance, bands shall continue west along Knox Street and disassemble on Abercromby Street.
- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
