A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 68 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago that the President, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, may at any time prorogue or dissolve Parliament:

And whereas it is deemed expedient that Parliament be prorogued:

Now, therefore, I, GEORGE MAXWELL RICHARDS, President as aforesaid, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 68 of the said Constitution do hereby prorogue Parliament at midnight on Friday 17th June, 2011.
