ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(CORPUS CHRISTI) ORDER, 2011

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary ^{Citation} Provisions) (Corpus Christi) Order, 2011.
2. This Order has effect between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and ^{Duration} 12.30 p.m. on Thursday 23rd June, 2011.
3. Parking is prohibited on—
 - (a) Independence Square North, between Nelson Street and ^{Parking} Wrightson Road; ^{prohibited}
 - (b) Independence Square South, between Nelson Street and Wrightson Road; and
 - (c) George Street, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South.
4. From 8.30 a.m. to 11.30 a.m., the following roads are closed to ^{Roads closed} vehicular traffic:
 - (a) Independence Square North, between Wrightson Road and Nelson Street;
 - (b) Independence Square South, between Nelson Street and Edward Street;
 - (c) Richmond Street, between London Street and Independence Square North;
 - (d) Edward Street, between Independence Square South and Queen Street;
 - (e) St. Vincent Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North;
 - (f) Chacon Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North;
 - (g) Frederick Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North;

(h) Charlotte Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North; and

(i) Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South, except for taxis referred to at clause 5(b).

Taxi stands

5. Taxis shall operate as follows:

(a) on call taxis assigned to taxi stands on Independence Square North shall operate from the western side of Abercromby Street, between Independence Square North and Queen Street, facing north; and

(b) taxis assigned to taxi stands on Broadway, Chacon Street, Henry Street, Charlotte Street and George Street, shall operate from their respective stands facing south, entering and leaving by way of South Quay only.

Removal and

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
