REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, CHAP. 48:50

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)
(VALSAYN SOUTH) REGULATIONS, 2011

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation
(Experimental Scheme) (Valsayn South) Regulations, 2011.

2. These Regulations shall commence on Monday 14th March, 2011 Duration
and shall cease on Sunday 12th June, 2011.

3. Motorist shall proceed in a northerly direction only on Taguaria One-way
Road, between Bimitti Street and the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway on traffic
Monday to Friday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. except
public holidays.

4. No motorist shall enter— No entry
- (a) Taguaria Road from Churchill-Roosevelt Highway on
Monday to Friday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and
9.00 a.m., except public holidays; and
 - (b) Springvale Road from the Southern Main Road on Monday
to Friday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m.
except public holidays.

5. Any Person who contravenes these Regulations is liable on Offence
summary conviction for a first offence to a fine of seven hundred and
fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand
dollars.

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and
commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in impounding
contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by the Police and of vehicles
impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the unlawfully
Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. parked

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (PASEA)
REGULATIONS, 2011

Citation 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control
(Experimental Scheme) (Pasea) Regulations, 2011.

Duration 2. These Regulations shall commence on Monday 21st March, 2011
and shall cease on Sunday 19th June, 2011.

Parking prohibited 3. Parking is prohibited on—
(a) Pasea Main Road, between Churchill-Roosevelt Highway
and Barath Street;
(b) Jackie Street, between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 6.00 p.m.
on Monday to Saturday except public holidays; and
(c) Boodoo Street, between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.
Monday to Saturday except public holidays.

Offence and penalty 4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions these
Regulations is liable on summary conviction for a first offence to a fine
of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction to
a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
Chap. 48:50 5. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the
commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in
contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by the Police and
impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the
Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
