REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE FISHERIES ACT

THE PROTECTION OF TURTLE AND TURTLE EGGS
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2011

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Protection of Turtle and Turtle Eggs (Amendment) Regulations, 2011. Citation

2. The Protection of Turtle and Turtle Eggs Regulations are amended— Chap. 67:51 amended

(a) by revoking regulation 2 and substituting the following regulation:

“Prohibition on taking, removing or selling of any turtle eggs

2. No person shall—

(a) take or remove or cause to be removed any turtle eggs after they have been laid and buried by any female turtle or after they have been buried by any person; or

(b) purchase, sell, offer or expose for sale or cause to be sold or offered or exposed for sale or be in possession of any turtle eggs.”; and

(b) by revoking regulation 3 and substituting the following regulation:

“Prohibition on killing, harpooning or selling of any turtle

3. No person shall, at any time, kill, harpoon, catch or otherwise take possession of any turtle, or purchase, sell, offer or expose for sale or cause to be sold or offered or exposed for sale any

turtle, turtle meat or any other part of the
turtle.”.
