ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF JUSTICE  
UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)  
(NO. 21) ORDER, 2012

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for <sup>Citation</sup> Admission) (No. 21) Order, 2012.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a <sup>Eligibility for</sup> Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales <sup>admission to</sup> for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law <sup>practise</sup> in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

Mr. Alan Ronald Harvey Newman, QC	Of the Honourable Society of Middle Temple: Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in November, 1968 and was appointed Queen's Counsel in 1989.

PART II

Mr. Alan Ronald Harvey Newman, QC, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following causes and any matters, suits or other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the causes, namely:

C.V. 2012–02501—Design Collaborative Associates Limited, Genivar Trinidad and Tobago Limited vs Urban Development Corporation of Trinidad and Tobago; and

C.V. 2012–02088—Genivar Trinidad and Tobago Limited and Genivar Incorporated (formerly known as Genivar Limited Partnership and Genivar GPM) vs the Urban Development Corporation of Trinidad and Tobago.
