ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF JUSTICE
UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 4) ORDER, 2013

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 4) Order, 2013.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART I

<i>Name</i>	<i>Professional Qualification</i>
Mr. Edward Nicholas Jenkins, QC	Of the Honourable Society of Middle Temple: Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in July, 1977 and was appointed Queen's Counsel in 2000.

PART II

Mr. Edward Nicholas Jenkins, QC, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following causes and any matters, suits or other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the cause, namely:

- (a) the Commission of Inquiry appointed to enquire into the failure of C.L. Financial Limited, Colonial Life Insurance Company (Trinidad) Limited, Clico Investment Bank Limited, British American Insurance Company (Trinidad) Limited, Caribbean Money Market Brokers Limited and the Hindu Credit Union Co-operative Society Limited and any matters, suits or other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the cause; and
- (b) any criminal proceedings arising from the Commission of enquiry appointed to enquire into the failure of C.L. Financial Limited, Colonial Life Insurance Company (Trinidad) Limited, Clico Investment Bank Limited, British American Insurance Company (Trinidad) Limited, Caribbean Money Market Brokers Limited and the Hindu Credit Union Co-operative Society Limited.
