THE LAND ACQUISITION ACT, CHAP. 58:01

NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A
PUBLIC PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcels of land described in the Schedule and situate in the Ward of Naparima in the County of Victoria and in the Ward of Siparia in the County of St. Patrick, respectively, are lands likely to be needed for a purpose, which, in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: namely the construction of the highway from San Fernando to Point Fortin.

SCHEDULE

A parcel of land comprising 5 acres, 3 roods and 36 perches more or less, bounded on the north, east and west by Crown land and on the south by a road reserve 50 links wide separating the lands herein from the lands of Mungur.

A parcel of land comprising 3 acres, 3 roods and 8 perches more or less, being a portion of the parcel of land known as Taymon Island and bounded on the north partly by an acquired portion of land now known as the Southern Main Road and partly by lands of Bruce Hobson and Oliver P. Bennet, on the south and on the east by lands of Bruce Hobson and Oliver P. Bennet and on the west by the acquired portion of land now known as the Southern Main Road.
