THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) through the Ministry of Health (MOH) has initiated a comprehensive Health Sector Reform Programme (HSRP) aimed at improving the quality of health care by changing organizational structure(s) and behaviour(s). A key component of the HSRP will be the effective utilization of information technology (IT) and the improvement of information systems (IS).
