A pre-tender meeting will be held on Wednesday 3rd November, 2004 at 10.00 a.m. at the Project Manager's Office.

Proposals must be accompanied by valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender. In addition, a Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act must be submitted.

Proposals will be evaluated in accordance with the following criteria:

An average of 70% must be obtained in order to qualify, with at least 50% in each category.

Prospective consultants are requested to hold their proposals valid for ninety (90) days from the date of the opening of the proposal.

One (1) original and six (6) copies each of the technical and financial proposals should be placed in separately sealed envelopes.

The envelopes should be marked: "Provision of consultancy services for design and supervision of construction of three (3) Primary Schools—PACKAGE C for the Ministry of Education".

Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board and deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office, Ground Floor, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain on or before 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 18th November, 2004. Technical proposals will be opened publicly shortly afterwards. The proposer or representative may attend the opening.
