AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago for the Financial Year ending 30th September, 2010.

[Assented to 28th September, 2009]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Short title (Financial Year 2010) Act, 2009.

Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorised

2. (1) The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of thirty-six thousand, nine hundred and fifteen million, three hundred and fifty-nine thousand, six hundred and fifty-eight dollars (\$36,915,359,658) is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2010, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of the Schedule.

Schedule

(2) The sum specified in the Second Column of the Schedule, in relation to the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of the Schedule, is appropriated out of the sum of thirty-six thousand, nine hundred and fifteen million, three hundred and fifty-nine thousand, six hundred and fifty-eight dollars (\$36,915,359,658) for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2010.

Commencement

3. This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 2009.
