- 4. In indictable matters, the Magistrate enquires whether a *prima facie* case is made out (whether there is sufficient evidence) for referral to the High Court, or may discharge the accused as the case may be.
- 5. Sits as Coroner under the Coroner's Act conducting inquests into unnatural deaths and fires.
- 6. Determines whether to grant bail to persons who are awaiting trial or the determination of an appeal.
- 7. Sits as Judge of the Petty Civil Court and adjudicates in certain civil matters.
- 8. Exercises jurisdiction in family matters, matters affecting the custody and maintenance of children, matters of domestic violence and juveniles brought before the Court.
- 9. Adjudicates in ejectment proceedings (Landlord/Tenant disputes).
- 10. Serves on tribunals as required e.g. Mental Health, Agricultural, etc.
- 11. Prepares and submits to the Court of Appeal, written reasons for decisions that are the subject to appeal.
- 12. Manages the proceedings in Court.
