NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT
SUBMITTED BY BP TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO LLC (bpTT)

NOTICE is hereby given that BP Trinidad and Tobago LLC is desirous of executing a project in the Northern Area Development (NAD) Serrette Field involving the installation of a 9-slot Well Protector Platform (WPP), drilling of five (5) wells from NAD-Serrette's WPP and the laying of 51 km, of 26-inch diameter sub-sea multiphase export pipeline in the South-East Galeota Block off the South-East Coast of Trinidad. This project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, as amended, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance ("the Certificate") pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, Chap. 35:05 ("the Act").

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority ("the Authority") has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, reasons for the proposed project and copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and the Authority's reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m., Monday to Friday from Monday 1st June, 2009 to Friday 3rd July, 2009:
