ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 18(2) OF THE STANDARDS ACT

COMPULSORY STANDARDS ORDER, 2009

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Standards Order, Citation 2009.

2. On the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, the following standards listed in the Second Column of the Schedule, which were notified in Legal Notice No. 131 of 2008, are declared compulsory standards for the purposes specified in the Third Column of the Schedule.

3. This Order comes into effect on the 4th day of August, 2009. Commencement
