REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (NO. 6)
REGULATIONS, 2009

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation
(Experimental Scheme) (No. 6) Regulations, 2009.
2. These Regulations shall have effect from Monday 17th August, Duration
2009 to Monday 16th November, 2009.

PART I

ENDEAVOUR

3. Motorists proceeding— No right turn
 - (a) west on the Endeavour Flyover shall not turn right onto the northbound ramp; and
 - (b) east on the Endeavour Flyover shall not turn right onto the southbound ramp.

PART II

PRINCES TOWN

4. Motorist shall proceed in a— One-way traffic
 - (a) northerly direction on Charlotte Street;
 - (b) southerly direction on Bonanza Street;
 - (c) westerly direction on Tramline Street, between Tramway Street and Naparima-Mayaro Road;
 - (d) southerly direction on Buen Intento Road from Theodore Street to Naparima-Mayaro Road;
 - (e) southerly direction along Morton Street, between Naparima-Mayaro Road and Mahabir Street, from 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays, except on school holidays;

- (f) westerly direction along the Naparima-Mayaro Road, between Manahambre Road and Tramline Street, from 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays, except on school holidays.
- Parking prohibited
5. Parking is prohibited on—
- (a) High Street (Naparima-Mayaro Road), between King Street and Lothians Road;
 - (b) King Street, between Naparima-Mayaro Road and Warterlane Street;
 - (c) Buen Intento Road, between Naparima-Mayaro Road and Theodore Street;
 - (d) Railway Road, between Naparima-Mayaro Road and Tramway Street;
 - (e) Lothians Road, between Naparima-Mayaro Road and Armour Street;
 - (f) the eastern side of Charlotte Street;
 - (g) the eastern side of Bonanza Street;
 - (h) the northern side of Waterlane Street; and
 - (i) Armour Street.
- Parking permitted
6. Parking is permitted on the—
- (a) western side of Charlotte Street;
 - (b) western side of Bonanza Street;
 - (c) southern side of Waterlane Street;
 - (d) northern side of French Street;
 - (e) western side of Tramline Street, between Naparima-Mayaro Road and Tramway Street; and
 - (f) western side of Morton Street.
- No right turn
7. Motorists—
- (a) proceeding west along Naparima-Mayaro Road shall not turn right onto Railway Road and Buen Intento Road;
 - (b) proceeding south along Railway Road shall not turn right onto Naparima-Mayaro Road; and
 - (c) exiting the Princes Town Car Park shall not turn right onto Naparima-Mayaro Road.
- Stopping or waiting prohibited
8. Motorists are prohibited from stopping or waiting on—
- (a) King Street, between Naparima-Mayaro Road and a point fifty metres north; and
 - (b) Naparima-Mayaro Road, between Bonanza Street and Lothians Road.

9. Taxis plying for hire shall park as follows: Taxi stands
- (a) a maximum of thirty-three taxis facing south, on the eastern side of Buen Intento Road and extending onto the northern side of Naparima-Mayaro Road, facing east;
 - (b) a maximum of fifteen taxis facing east, on the northern side of the Naparima-Mayaro Road, from Railway Road and extending westwards;
 - (c) a maximum of thirteen taxis facing east, on the northern side of Cacique Street;
 - (d) a maximum of six taxis facing south, on the western side of Bonanza Street, from the Naparima-Mayaro Road and extending southwards; and
 - (e) a maximum of four taxis facing east, on the southern side of Tramline Street, from Lothians Road and extending westwards.

10. Maxi-taxis plying for hire shall park as follows: Maxi stands
- (a) a maximum of twenty-two maxi-taxis operating the Princes Town to San Fernando route shall park facing east on the southern side of Tramline Street, from Railway Road and extending westwards, as marked; and
 - (b) a maximum of forty-four maxi-taxis operating the Princes Town to Rio Claro, Tableland, Moruga, St. Mary's, Sixth Company, Circular Road and New Grant routes, shall park facing south on the western side of the Princes Town Car Park, as marked.

PART III

ST. ANN'S

11. Parking is prohibited on both sides of St. Ann's Road, from the St. Ann's Roundabout to a point one hundred metres north. Parking prohibited

PART IV

GENERAL

12. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Regulations is liable on summary conviction for a first offence, to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars, and on any subsequent conviction, to a fine of one thousand dollars. Offence and penalty

13. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
