NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT SUBMITTED BY RAPID ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (2003) LIMITED IN ASSOCIATION WITH EARTH TECH AECOM ON BEHALF OF THE WATER AND SEWERAGE AUTHORITY

NOTICE is hereby given that the Water and Sewerage Authority is desirous of establishing two (2) Wastewater Treatment Plants and associated appurtenances to service the Maloney and Malabar areas. This project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, as amended, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, from Monday 7th September, 2009 to Friday 9th October, 2009:
