A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS section 238(1) of the Defence Act, Chap. 14:01 provides among other things, that the President may call out the Volunteer Defence Force or any portion of it for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in any case in which a riot, disturbance of the peace, or other emergency requiring such service occurs, or is, in the opinion of the President, anticipated as likely to occur, and in either case to be beyond the powers of the civil authorities to suppress, or to prevent, or deal with:

And whereas the President deems it necessary to call out to duty other ranks of the Volunteer Defence Force for a period of one hundred and four days to serve as a reserve corps to assist the civil authorities in providing security support for the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) scheduled to take place in Port-of-Spain from 27th to 29th November, 2009 as well as for the Christmas 2009 and Carnival 2010 periods:

Now, therefore, I, GEORGE MAXWELL RICHARDS, President as aforesaid, hereby call out for a period of one hundred and four days with effect from 17th November, 2009 to 28th February, 2010, ten officers and one hundred and thirty-one other ranks of the Trinidad and Tobago Volunteer Defence Force, for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in the maintenance of peace and security in Trinidad and Tobago.
