ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (THE
STATE VISIT BY HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH II
AND HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS PRINCE PHILIP AND THE
COMMONWEALTH HEADS OF GOVERNMENT MEETING)
ORDER, 2009

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (The State Visit by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and His Royal Highness Prince Philip and the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting) Order, 2009.

2. This Order has effect from 6.00 a.m. on Thursday 26th November, 2009 to 10.00 p.m. on Sunday 29th November, 2009.

PART I

PORT-OF-SPAIN

3. (1) Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited between the hours of 3.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Thursday 26th November, 2009 on the following:

- (a) Queen's Park West, from Cipriani Boulevard to Queen's Park East;
- (b) Chancery Lane, from Gordon Street to Queen's Park West;
- (c) Keate Street, from Chancery Lane to Queen's Park East;
and
- (d) Frederick Street, from Keate Street to Queen's Park West.

(2) Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on Dock Road from Wrightson Road to the east gate of the Port of Port-of-Spain from 12.00 midday on Thursday 26th November, 2009 to 10.00 p.m. on Sunday 29th November, 2009.

(3) Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on Coblenz Avenue from St. Ann's Road to 50 metres north of the entrance to Carlton Savannah Hotel from 4.00 p.m. on Thursday 26th November, 2009 to 8.00 p.m. on Saturday 28th November, 2009.

(4) Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited from 12.00 midnight on Thursday 26th November, 2009 to 10.00 p.m. on Sunday 29th November, 2009 on the following:

- (a) Wrightson Road, from Edward Street to Duke Street;
- (b) Richmond Street, from Sackville Street to Independence Square South;
- (c) London Street;
- (d) Ajax Street; and
- (e) Post Office Road.

(5) Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. on Friday 27th November, 2009 on the following:

- (a) Queen's Park West, from Cipriani Boulevard to Queen's Park East;
- (b) Chancery Lane, from Gordon Street to Queen's Park West;
- (c) Keate Street, from Queen's Park East to Chancery Lane;
- (d) Frederick Street, from Gordon Street to Queen's Park West;
- (e) Dundonald Street, from Queen's Park West to Albion Street;
- (f) Albion Street, from Dundonald Street to Chancery Lane; and
- (g) Pembroke Street, from Gordon Street to Keate Street.

One-way traffic

4. Drivers shall proceed along Duke Street from Victoria Square to Wrightson Road in a westerly direction only from 12.00 midnight on Thursday 26th November, 2009 to 10.00 p.m. on Sunday 29th November, 2009.

Two-way traffic

5. Drivers may proceed in either direction on Park Street from Edward Street to Victoria Square West from 12.00 midnight on Thursday 26th November, 2009 to 10.00 p.m. on Sunday 29th November, 2009.

6. (1) Parking is prohibited from 6.00 a.m. on Thursday 26th November, 2009 to 10.00 p.m. on Sunday 29th November, 2009 on the following:

- (a) Edward Street;
- (b) Duke Street;
- (c) Park Street; and
- (d) Colville Street.

(2) Parking is prohibited between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. daily from Friday 27th November, 2009 to Sunday 29th November, 2009 on the following:

- (a) Richmond Street;
- (b) Dundonald Street;
- (c) St. Vincent Street;
- (d) Abercromby Street;
- (e) Frederick Street;
- (f) Henry Street;
- (g) Charlotte Street;
- (h) Piccadilly Street;
- (i) Tragarete Road;
- (j) Ariapita Avenue; and
- (k) Cipriani Boulevard.

7. Drivers of taxis and maxi-taxis whose normal route is along Wrightson Road, shall use any of the following streets from 12.00 midnight on Thursday 26th November, 2009 to 10.00 p.m. on Sunday 29th November, 2009:

- (a) Edward Street;
- (b) Abercromby Street;
- (c) Henry Street;
- (d) Duke Street; and
- (e) Park Street.

8. Drivers of Public Transport Service Corporation buses whose normal route is along Wrightson Road, shall use any of the following:

streets from 12.00 midnight on Thursday 26th November, 2009 to 10.00 p.m. on Sunday 29th November, 2009:

- (a) Edward Street;
- (b) Abercromby Street;
- (c) Duke Street; and
- (d) Park Street.

Vehicular traffic route—container less than 20 feet

9. Trailers conveying containers no more than 20 feet in length from the Port, from west to east shall turn left along Audrey Jeffers Highway, right along Maraval Parkway, turn right along Ariapita Avenue onto Park Street and south along either St. Vincent Street or Piccadilly Street exiting onto Independence Square or Old St. Joseph Road.

Vehicular traffic route—20 containers

10. Trailers conveying containers no more than 20—feet in length from east to west shall turn right from Wrightson Road onto Edward Street, left onto Park Street and onto Ariapita Avenue and left onto French Street onto Wrightson Road into the entrance of the Port.

40-foot containers prohibited

11. Trailers conveying 40-foot containers shall be prohibited from travelling on the streets of Port-of-Spain from 12.00 midnight on Thursday 26th November, 2009 to 10.00 p.m. on Sunday 29th November, 2009.

PART II

TOBAGO

Parking prohibited

12. Parking is prohibited between the hours of 12.00 midday and 3.00 p.m. on Friday 27th November, 2009 on the following:

- (a) Bacolet Street;
- (b) Bacolet Street Extension;
- (c) Old Farm Road, between Crusoe By Pass and Scarborough Secondary School;
- (d) Crusoe By Pass, between Old Farm Road and Orange Hill Road; and
- (e) Orange Hill Road, between Crusoe By Pass and Claude Noel Highway.

PART III

GENERAL

13. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. ^{Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked}
