# THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (ST. JAMES, SAN FERNANDO AND PORT-OF-SPAIN CHILDREN'S CARNIVAL PARADE OF BANDS) ORDER, 2009

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (St. James, San Fernando and Port-of-Spain Children's Carnival Parade of Bands) Order, 2009.
  - 2. This Order shall have effect in-

Duration

- (a) St. James, from midday to 7.00 p.m. on Sunday 15th February, 2009;
- (b) San Fernando, from 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on Sunday 22nd February, 2009; and
- (c) Port-of-Spain, from 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on Saturday 21st February, 2009.

# PART I

# St. James

- 3. Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on Western Main Road closed Road, between Roxy Roundabout and George Cabral Street.

7. Vehicular traffic proceeding west along Naparima-Mayaro Road, shall turn right onto Circular Road.

Left turn only

8. Vehicular traffic proceeding west along Navet Road, shall turn left onto Bertrand Street.

#### PART III

#### PORT-OF-SPAIN

Roads closed and parking prohibited

- 9. Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on—
  - (a) Knox Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;
  - (b) Hart Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;
  - (c) Abercromby Street, between South Quay and Duke Street;
  - (d) Independence Square North, between Henry Street and St. Vincent Street;
  - (e) Independence Square South, between Henry Street and St. Vincent Street;
  - (f) Broadway, between Beetham Highway and Independence Square South;
  - (g) Frederick Street;
  - (h) Queen Street, between Henry Street and St. Vincent Street;
  - (i) Duke Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
  - (j) Park Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
  - (k) Oxford Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;
  - (1) New Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;

- (m) Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;
- (n) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;
- (o) Charlotte Street, between Oxford Street and Queen's Park East;
- (p) Henry Street, between Park Street and Oxford Street;
- (q) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane; and
- (r) Queen's Park East, between Queen's Park West and Jerningham Avenue.
- 10. Parking is prohibited on—

Parking prohibited

- (a) Chancery Lane;
- (b) Dundonald Street, between Queen's Park West and New Street; and
- (c) Albion Street, between Chancery Lane and Victoria Avenue.
- 11. Vehicular traffic shall proceed in a westerly direction only on— One-way traffic only
  - (a) Keate Street, between Pembroke Street and Chancery Lane;
  - (b) Gordon Street, between Pembroke Street and St. Vincent Street; and
  - (c) Albion Street.
- 12. Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, vehicular Two-way traffic shall proceed in both directions—
  - (a) around the Queen's Park Savannah, between Queen's Royal College Roundabout and Queen's Park East, by way of Jerningham Avenue;
  - (b) on Belmont Circular Road, between Observatory Street and Charlotte Street (entrance to hospital); and
  - (c) on Observatory Street, between Charlotte Street and Gloster Lodge Road.
  - 13. Taxis plying for hire shall operate as follows:

Taxi stands

(a) St. Ann's taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the southern side of Queen Street, between St. Vincent Street and Edward Street;

- (b) St. James taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the western side of Edward Street, between Independence Square North and Queen Street;
- (c) Ice House/Broadway/Marine Square taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the northern and southern sides of Independence Square North, between St. Vincent Street and Wrightson Road;
- (d) San Fernando taxi drivers shall ply for hire west of Broadway on the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway, facing east;
- (e) Chaguanas taxi drivers shall ply for hire east of Broadway on the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway, facing east;
- (f) Long Circular/Wrightson Road taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the southern side of Independence Square South, between St. Vincent Street and Wrightson Road, facing west; and
- (g) Diego Martin/Petit Valley taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the northern side of Independence Square South, between St. Vincent Street and Wrightson Road, facing west.

Band route

14. Carnival bands shall proceed from Knox Street, south along Abercromby Street to South Quay, east along South Quay to Broadway, north along Broadway to Independence Square North, north along Frederick Street to Oxford Street, east along Oxford Street to Charlotte Street, north along Charlotte Street to the top of Memorial Park and west along Queen's Park West, turning and continuing along the parade route.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked

15. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
