THE VISITING FORCES (DESIGNATED STATES) ORDER, 2009

1. This Order may be cited as the Visiting Forces (Designated States) Order, 2009. Citation

2. In this Order, the “Act” means the Visiting Forces Act, 2007. Interpretation
No. 8 of 2007

3. The following countries are designated as designated States for the purposes of the Act: Designated
States

1. The Bahamas
2. Barbados
3. Belize
4. Brazil
5. Canada
6. Colombia
7. Guyana
8. Jamaica
9. St. Kitts and Nevis
10. Suriname
11. United States of America.

4. The application of the Act shall, in respect of a designated State, be limited to such activities as are agreed upon between that State and the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago. Extent of the

5. Civilian personnel of the United States of America present in Trinidad and Tobago in connection with the official duties of its visiting force are hereby designated a civilian component of that visiting force. United States’
