Made by the Commissioner of Police with the consent of the Minister of Works and Transport under section 67(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

# THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS, 2009

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (Experimental Scheme) (No. 3) Regulations, 2009.
- 2. These Regulations shall have effect from Monday 6th April, Duration 2009 to Monday 29th June, 2009.

#### St. Ann's

- 3. Parking is prohibited on both sides of St. Ann's Road, between Parking the entrance to the Official Residence of the Prime Minister and the prohibited Diplomatic Centre, and La Fantasie Road.
  - 4. Motorists are prohibited from stopping or waiting on—

Stopping or waiting prohibited

- (a) St. Ann's Road for a distance of fifty metres both north and south of its intersection; and
- (b) south of its intersection with the entrance to the Official Residence of the Prime Minister and the Diplomatic Centre.

## GENERAL

5. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Offence and Regulations is liable on summary conviction for a first offence, to a fine penalty of seven hundred and fifty dollars, and on any subsequent conviction, to a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
