MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF  
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(POINT FORTIN BOROUGH DAY CELEBRATIONS) ORDER,  
2009

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Point Fortin Borough Day Celebrations) Order, 2009.

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 6.00 p.m. on Duration Friday 1st May, 2009 and 6.00 a.m. on Sunday 3rd May, 2009.

3. Parking is prohibited on the following—

Parking  
prohibited

- (a) Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road;
- (b) Point Fortin Main Road, between Dunlop Roundabout and Reid Road;
- (c) Tank Farm Road;
- (d) Canaan Road;
- (e) Techier Main Road, between Point Fortin Main Road and Kalloo Road;
- (f) Volunteer Road;
- (g) Richardson Street; and
- (h) Clifton Hill.

4. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on the following:

- (a) Point Fortin Main Road, between Reid Road and Tanner Street;
- (b) Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road, between Reid Road and Tank Farm Road;
- (c) Adventure Road;

(d) Richardson Street, between Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road and Canaan Road; and

(e) Techier Main Road, between Kalloo Road and Adventure Street.

Emergency route

5. Drivers on an emergency shall proceed on Atlantic Avenue, onto Old Point Ligoure Road, onto Refinery Road, onto Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road, onto Clifton Hill, onto Clifton Crescent, onto Volunteer Road and onto Richardson Street.

Taxi stands

6. Drivers of taxis shall operate as follows:

(a) San Fernando taxi drivers shall operate from the western side of Reid Road, north of the Point Fortin Main Road; and

(b) Erin taxi drivers shall operate from the intersection of Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road and Reid Road, in the vicinity of the gas station.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
