MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF JUSTICE  
UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)  
(NO. 3) ORDER, 2009

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 3) Order, 2009.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

Dr. Lloyd George Barnett	Of the Honourable Society of Lincoln's Inn; Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in July, 1960.

PART II

Dr. Lloyd George Barnett is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following Commission of Enquiry and any cause, matter, suit or other proceeding arising out of or in connection with the said Commission of Enquiry, namely:

Commission of Enquiry into the construction sector established under the Commission of Enquiry Act, Chap. 19:01.
