THE APPROPRIATION (FINANCIAL YEAR 2011) BILL, 2010

Explanatory Note

(These notes form no part of the Bill but are intended only to indicate its general purport)

The Bill seeks to provide for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending 30th September, 2011 by authorizing the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of forty-one thousand, three hundred and fifty-two million, three hundred and thirty-nine thousand, five hundred and one dollars (\$41,352,339,501).

BILL

An Act to provide for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the Financial Year ending 30th September, 2011

[, 2010]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation short title (Financial Year 2011) Act, 2010.

Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorized 2. (1) The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of forty-one thousand, three hundred and fifty-two million, three hundred and thirty-nine thousand, five hundred and one dollars (\$41,352,339,501) is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2011, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of the Schedule.

Schedule

(2) The sum specified in the Second Column of the Schedule, in relation to the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of the Schedule, is appropriated out of the sum of forty-one thousand, three hundred and fifty-two million, three hundred and thirty-nine thousand, five hundred and one dollars (\$41,352,339,501) for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2011.

Commencement

3. This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 2010.
