Act No. 16 of 2012

An Act to provide for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2013

[Assented to 19th October, 2012]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Short title (Financial Year 2013) Act, 2012.

Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorized No. 16

2. (1) The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of fifty-one thousand, one hundred and ninety-four million, six hundred and eighty-one thousand, eight hundred and thirty-one dollars (\$51,194,681,831) is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2013, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of the Schedule.

Schedule

(2) The sum specified in the Second Column of the Schedule, in relation to the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of the Schedule, is appropriated out of the sum of fifty-one thousand, one hundred and ninety-four million, six hundred and eighty-one thousand, eight hundred and thirty-one dollars (\$51,194,681,831) for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2013.

Commencement

3. This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 2012.
