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INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—July, 2012 (Base: January, 2003 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of July, 2012 was 202.3 representing an increase of 1.7 point or 0.8% above the All Items Index for June, 2012.

The percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January to July, 2012 over the period January to July, 2011 was 10.2%. This reflects an increase when compared with the rate of inflation of 6.3% observed in the average All Items Index for the period January to July, 2011 over the average All Items Index for January to July, 2010.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 497.4 in June, 2012 to 501.6 in July, 2012, reflecting an increase of 0.8%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of ochroes, hot peppers, dasheen, green pigeon peas, watercress, tomatoes, pawpaw, oranges, whole chickens and limes. However, the full impact of these price increases was offset by the general decrease in the prices of cucumbers, sweet potatoes, celery, chive/thyme, melongenes, yams, melon, plantains, carite and irish potatoes.

Price changes in this section, for the month of July, 2012, accounted for a net overall increase of 0.8 points in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for July, 2012 compared with June, 2012 reflected increases in the sub-indices for Recreation and Culture 3.0%, Hotels, Cafes and Restaurants 2.4%, Clothing and Footwear 2.3%, Health 1.4%, Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Maintenance of the House 1.2%, Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.5% and Housing, Water, Electricity and Gas 0.3%. However a decline was noted in the sub-index for Miscellaneous Goods and Services of 0.2%.

Price changes in the Other Sections, for the month of July, 2012 accounted for a net overall increase of 0.9 points in the All Items Index.
