INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—December, 2011 (Base: January, 2003 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of December, 2011 was 189.7 representing an increase of 0.1 point or 0.1% above the Index for November, 2011.

The annual rate of inflation as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January–December, 2011, over that for the period January–December, 2010 was 5.1%. This reflects a decrease when compared with a rate of inflation of 10.6% observed in the average All Items Index for the period January–December, 2010 over the average All Items Index for January–December, 2009.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 444.2 in November, 2011 to 444.5 in December, 2011, reflecting an increase of 0.1%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of limes, sweet potatoes, yams, carite, dasheen, canned vegetables, oranges, bodi, king fish and chive/thyme. However, the full impact of these price increases was offset by the general decrease in the prices of cucumber, celery, christophene, hot peppers, ochroes, mangoes, melongene, plantain, carrots and paw paw.

Price changes in this section, for the month of December, 2011 accounted for a net overall increase of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for December, 2011, compared with November, 2011, reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco 1.6%, Health 0.5% and Recreation and Culture 0.1%. However, a decline was noted in the sub-indice for Clothing and Footwear 0.6%.

Price changes in these sections for the month of December, 2011, had a negligible impact on the All Items Index.
