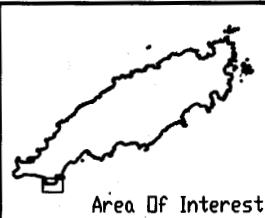
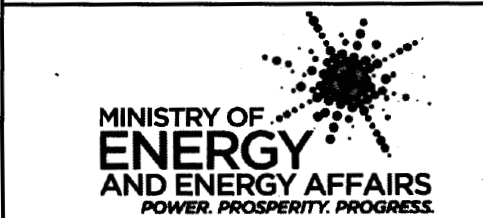
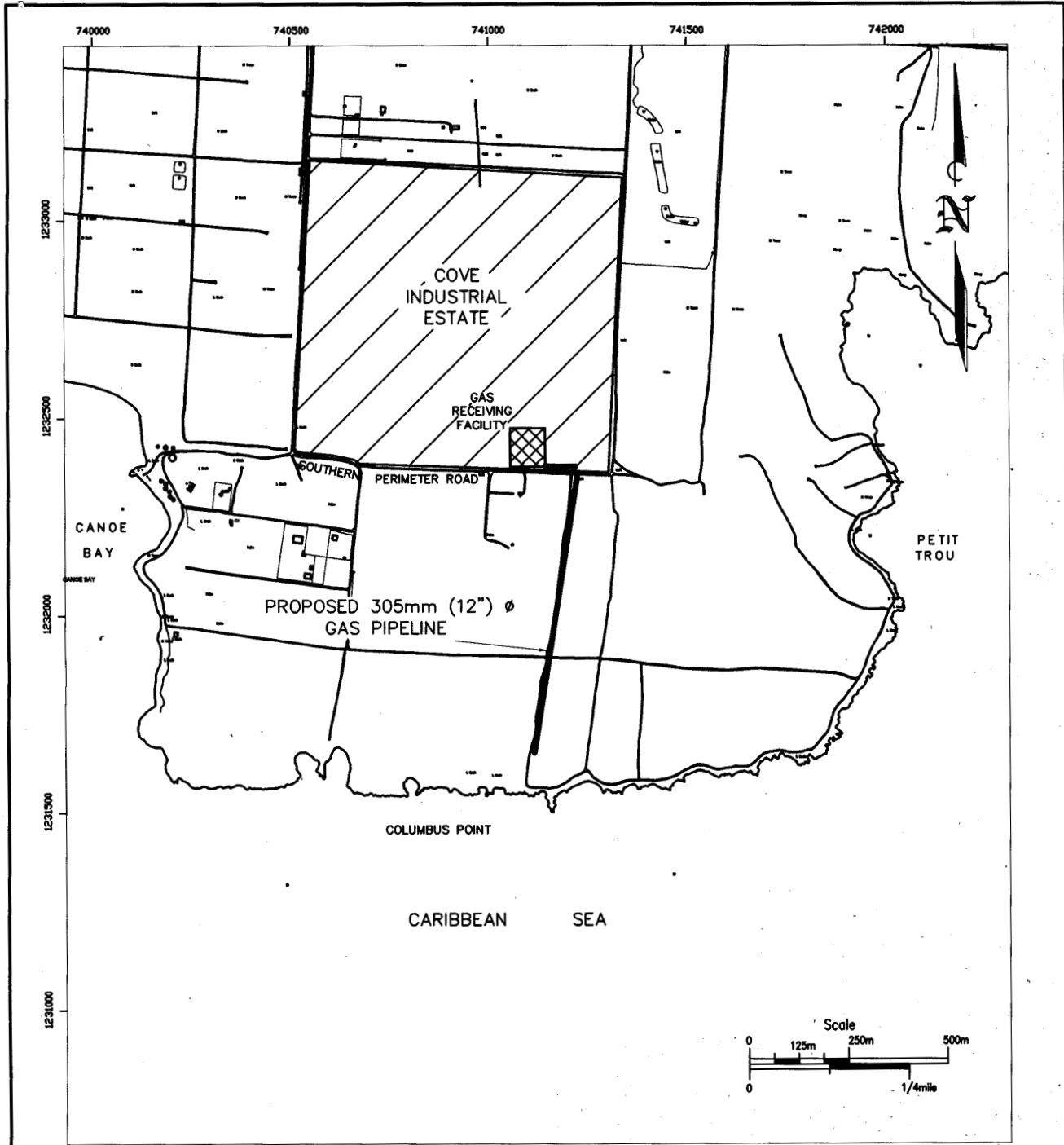
## SCHEDULE ABOVE REFERRED TO—DESCRIPTION OF PIPELINE

<i>Route</i>	The proposed 304.80 mm (12.00-inch) onshore natural gas pipeline pipeline will start at, landfall of the Horizontal Directional Drill (HDD) shore approach, where it will connect to the offshore Tobago pipeline at Columbus Point, Tobago. The onshore pipeline will proceed in a northerly direction for 0.73 km (0.45 mile). It will turn northwest, travel 39.00 m (128.00 feet) and enter the Cove Estate. From here the proposed pipeline will extend west a further 33.00 m (108.00 feet) and terminate at the proposed NGC Gas Receiving Facility. Reference Map "A".
<i>Length</i>	0.80 km (0.50 miles).
<i>Specification of Pipeline</i>	Outside Diameter—323.80 mm (12.75 inch) Wall Thickness—12.70 mm (0.50 inch) Grade of Pipe—API 5L—X65 Seamless
<i>Material of Construction</i>	Carbon Steel.
<i>Coating Specification</i>	External: 0.36 mm (14.00 mils) Fusion Bonded Epoxy (FBE) in accordance with NACE Standard RP 0394 with 0.76 mm (30.00 mils) Abrasion Resistant Overlay. Internal: 0.08 mm (3.00 mils) High Gloss Epoxy Flow Coating in accordance with API RP5L2.
<i>Fabrication</i>	The line pipe will be welded together in accordance with API Standard 1104 "Welding of Pipeline and Related Facilities" and all butt welds will be subject to 100% radiographic inspection while all fillet welds will be Magnetic Particle Inspected (MPI).
<i>Cathodic Protection</i>	The Cathodic Protection System type will be a single anode groundbed consisting of packaged magnesium anodes installed near the onshore facilities.
<i>Depth of Line</i>	The proposed pipeline will be buried at a minimum depth of 1.20 m (3.93 feet) below ground level on normal grade.
<i>Fluid for Transmission</i>	Natural Gas.
<i>Maximum Allowable Operating Pressure</i>	99.30 barg (1440.00 psig).
<i>Design Pressure</i>	99.30 barg (1440.00 psig).
