A PROCLAMATION

Whereas section 238(1) of the Defence Act, Chap. 14:01 provides, *inter alia*, that the President may call out the Volunteer Defence Force or any portion of it for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in any case in which a riot, disturbance of the peace, or other emergency requiring such service occurs, or is, in the opinion of the President, anticipated as likely to occur, and in either case to be beyond the powers of the civil authorities to suppress, or to prevent, or deal with:

And whereas the President deems it necessary to call out to duty two officers and sixty-two other ranks of the Trinidad and Tobago Volunteer Defence Force to serve as a reserve corps to assist the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force (Regiment) in battalion guard and combat service support duties:

Now, therefore, I, GEORGE MAXWELL RICHARDS, President as aforesaid, hereby call out to duty two officers and sixty-two other ranks of the Trinidad and Tobago Volunteer Defence Force for the

period 18th June, 2012 to 17th September, 2012, to serve as a reserve corps to assist the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force (Regiment) in battalion guard and combat service support duties.
