Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (CEREMONIAL OPENING OF PARLIAMENT) ORDER, 2012

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Ceremonial Opening of Parliament) Order, 2012.
- 2. This Order has effect between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and Duration 6.00 p.m. on Wednesday 11th July, 2012.
- 3. Vehicular traffic proceeding west along Independence Square $_{\text{Traffic}}$ South shall turn north on reaching Edward Street between the hours of $^{\text{diverted}}$ 12.00 midday and 3.30 p.m.
- 4. (1) Subject to subclause (2), vehicular traffic is prohibited on the vehicular following roads between the hours of 12.00 midday and 3.30 p.m.:

 traffic prohibited
 - (a) Independence Square South, between Edward Street and Wrightson Road; and
 - (b) the westbound carriageway of Wrightson Road, between Edward Street and Sackville Streets.
 - (2) Vehicular traffic is permitted for—
 - (a) the President of the Senate;
 - (b) the Speaker of the House; and
 - (c) Ministers of Government.
- 5. Parking is prohibited on the following roads between the hours $_{parking}$ of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.:
 - (a) Wrightson Road;
 - (b) Edward Street;

- (c) Independence Square North;
- (d) Independence Square South;
- (e) Richmond Street;
- (f) Dock Road;
- (g) South Quay; and
- (h) London Street.

Two Way Traffic 6. Vehicular traffic may proceed in both directions along the eastbound carriageway of Wrightson Road, between Edward Street and Sackville Street between the hours of 12.00 midday and 3.30 p.m.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
