MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 29 OF THE PETROLEUM ACT AND SUBJECT TO NEGATIVE RESOLUTION OF PARLIAMENT

THE PETROLEUM (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2012

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Petroleum (Amendment) Citation Regulations, 2012.

2. The Petroleum Regulations are amended in regulation 22 as Regulation 22 and follows:

(a) in subregulation (1)—

- (i) by inserting immediately after the words "subregulations (2)", the words ", (2A)";
- (ii) by deleting the words "four thousand" and substituting the words "forty thousand";
- (b) in subregulation (2), by deleting paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) and substituting the following paragraphs:
