Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (MULTICULTURAL EXTRAVAGANZA AND INDEPENDENCE RE-ENACTMENT) ORDER, 2012

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Multicultural Extravaganza and Independence Re-enactment) Order, 2012.
- 2. This Order shall have effect from 6.00 a.m. on Thursday Duration 30th August, 2012 to 6.00 a.m. on Friday 31st August, 2012.
 - 3. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on—

Roads closed

- (a) Frederick Street, between Park Street and Queen Street;
- (b) Queen Street, between Henry Street and Abercromby Street;
- (c) Abercromby Street, between Queen Street and Duke Street:
- (d) Duke Street, between Abercromby Street and Frederick Street; and
- (e) Hart Street, between St. Vincent Street and Abercromby Street.
- 4. Taxi drivers who normally ply—

Taxi stand

- (a) the St. Ann's route, from the taxi stand on Hart Street, shall operate from the northern side of Independence Square North, between Chacon Street and Frederick Street; and
- (b) the St. James route, from the taxi stand on Hart Street, shall operate from the northern side of Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Henry Street.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 5. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
